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eVeR safe pilot training
session

The eVeR safe project has entered its **final implementation phase**. Following the development of the training curriculum, educational videos, and Virtual Reality scenarios, partner organisations have begun pilot testing the training programme with autistic adults in their respective countries. These pilot trainings allow partners to evaluate how the materials work in real learning environments and how effectively participants can practice safety skills using the developed resources. At the same time, partners are working on reviewing and improving the training manual, ensuring that the final materials are clear, accessible, and easy to use for trainers, educators, and support professionals.

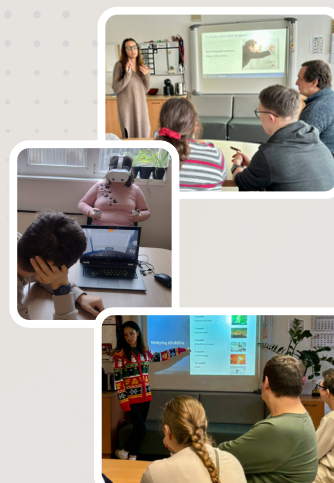
Testing and improving the eVeR safe training programme

Pilot trainings are currently being implemented in partner organisations across Europe.

During the sessions, participants test the eVeR safe training materials and practice responding to emergency situations that may occur in everyday life.

Using Virtual Reality simulations, participants can safely experience these situations and learn how to react step by step with the support of trained facilitators.

At the same time, partners are reviewing and improving the eVeR safe Training Manual based on feedback collected during the pilot sessions. The final version of the manual will support trainers and organisations in delivering effective safety training for autistic adults.

Looking ahead

As the project approaches its final stage, partners will continue the pilot trainings and complete the final improvements of the training materials.

The next steps include:

- completing pilot training sessions in partner organisations,
- finalising the training manual and educational materials,
- preparing the final project results,
- continuing dissemination activities to share the outcomes with wider communities.

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
